My role as a Mediator is to help the parties resolve their conflicting interests. Different types of disputes and each party's preference affect my methodology. There is no single mediation method that works for everyone. Integrating a facilitative, evaluative, and transformative approach is art. Among others, understanding-based mediation is of paramount importance.

Resolving conflicting interests through mediation is only possible with an understanding of the industry background, underlying commercial reasons, and each party's emotions. Another dispute may arise if the parties settle the issue without resolving their conflicting interests through mutual understanding.

Moreover, I have witnessed many cases where parties could not reach an agreement without reasonable cause solely due to an emotional confrontation. We tend to believe that our action is driven by logical analysis, but history proves that this is an illusion.
