As an enthusiastic learner of new facts and legal issues, I strive to mediate all disputes in a fair, reasonable and pragmatic manner.

I would begin each mediation by identifying the core interests of each party and distinguishing the core issues from the subsidiary interests. I would then delve into an analysis of the intricate interplay between these core interests and assess whether there are conflicts between them. At the same time, I would evaluate the relationship between the core issues and the subsidiary interests, examining whether the cumulative effect of the subsidiary concerns could elevate them to the significance of a core issue.
