**MEDIATION EXPERIENCE**

**• Mediation Style:**

Because the vast majority of civil cases settle before the trial or hearing, I feel it is beneficial to achieve settlement at a relatively early stage in the litigation or arbitration, or even before a suit or claim is filed. Early settlement not only results in a saving (sometimes a considerable saving) in time and costs, but also it may preserve business or personal relationships. As a mediator I may introduce avenues to resolve the dispute that would not be possible in a litigation or arbitration. Generally, I start the mediation as a facilitator; but after the issues have been aired, and the parties seem to be moving toward a settlement, I may, with their consent, become an evaluator to bring the parties to settlement.

**• Mediation Institutions Enlisted as a Mediator:**

I am accredited as a mediator by the Centre for Effective Dispute Resolution (CEDR).

I am listed as a mediator at the AAA/ICDR and the New York State Supreme Court Appellate and Commercial Divisions.

**• Others (related experience with international mediation):**

I have mediated several international cases as a Special Master at the Appellate Division, First Department, of the New York State Supreme Court. Issues that have been included in those mediations include sovereign immunity, force majeure, confidentiality, sanctions, fraud, insolvency and the enforcement of foreign arbitral awards under the New York Convention.
