I would describe myself as both an evaluative mediator as well as being a transformative mediator.

At the outset of a case, I would assess the strength of each party's position, often drawing on their legal expertise, and evaluate potential court outcomes. This approach can be efficient for disputes focused on reaching a fair settlement, especially when parties are unsure of their legal standing or need help narrowing down options.

At the same time, I like to deep dive into the underlying needs and interests behind the conflict. I help the parties understand each other's perspectives, empathize with one another, and potentially address the root causes of the disagreement. While it may take longer, this approach can lead to transformative resolutions that improve relationships and prevent future conflicts.
