MEDIATION EXPERIENCE

• Mediation Style:

I am good at listening and communicating, and can effectively collaborate with mediation team members to complete tasks together. In my past mediation work experience, I have often collaborated with people from different backgrounds and cultures to resolve disputes, which has enabled me to better understand and respect the views of others in mediation.

I possess the ability and experience to serve as a mediator in international commercial arbitration. As a legal professional with over 20 years of experience, I possess a profound foundation in law and extensive experience in legal practice as well as mediation work. Since I started practicing, I have provided full legal services for dozens of South Korean enterprises such as Putie (Qingdao) Steel Processing Co., Ltd. and Peiming Metal in their investment projects in China. I have also undertaken equity transfer and liquidation business for more than 20 South Korean investment enterprises, including Qingdao Yunshan Golf Course, Sirell Heavy Industry (Yantai) Co., Ltd., and Nanshan Hotel. I have also undertaken dozens of international trade related cases, including dispute resolution between South Korean Agricultural and Aquatic Products Circulation Corporation and Linyi Garlic Farmers and Garlic Trade, the dissolution of Shandong Xiangmao, a Sino South Korean joint venture, the disposal of non-performing assets at Hana Bank Qingdao Branch, etc. I have served as a long-term legal advisor for a few tens of South Korean investment companies, including Lotte Mart, Qingdao Nike Tire, Benjia Catering, Qingdao Yongyuan Clothing, South Korea Export Import Bank, and Busan Bank, etc. I am currently a specially appointed legal advisor to the Consulate General of South Korea in Qingdao, the Qingdao Trade Center of Korea Trade Promotion Corporation, and the Qingdao Korean Association.

I possess excellent coordination and communication skills, as well as empathy, and am capable of serving as an international commercial dispute mediator in the long term. I believe that mediators should possess three 'senses' in the mediation work. The first 'sense' is a sense of justice. The premise for mediators to engage in mediation work is to be fair, just, reasonable and legal, so as not to disappoint the trust of each party in us. The second 'sense' is empathy. The purpose of a mediator's work is to solve problems for the parties involved. During the mediation process, we should empathize with the key points of the parties' problems and conflicts, so as to use methods that the parties can accept and understand to interpret and ultimately resolve the dispute. The third 'sense' is calm inside. Engaging in mediation work often leads to the accumulation of a large number of negative emotions. Mediators should have the ability to deal with unpleasant work, and face every mediation case with a calm heart, to solve each case well in long-term work.
